## Fundamentals of Growing Cannabis

### EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

Flowering, Drying, Curing	
	<b>Nutrients for Flowering Stage:</b> Pre-mixed nutrients for flowering growth (e.g., N-P-K ratio of 2-8-6) or individual nutrients to create your own mix.
	<b>Other Soil Amendments:</b> May include worm castings, other manures, and compost to provide a combination of macro and micro nutrients to the plant.
	<b>Microscope or Magnifying Glass (Optional):</b> Needed to effectively inspect trichomes.
	<b>Pruning Shears or Small Scissors:</b> Needed to cut thicker branches and trim harvested buds.
	<b>String:</b> Will be needed to hang harvested buds for drying.
	<b>Mason Jars/Airtight Containers:</b> Needed for curing of dried and trimmed buds.
	<b>Drying Rack (Optional):</b> May be used to dry harvested buds in lieu of hang drying.
	<b>Air Purifier (Optional):</b> Filters odor causing particles. May be needed during drying to limit smell if not using carbon filter. Not necessary if already using carbon air filter throughout the grow.
	<b>Humidifier/De-humidifier (Optional):</b> May be needed during flowering if growing in extra dry or extra humid conditions. May be needed during drying if environment is too humid even with proper circulation. Avg. humidity is 40-50%.
